

WHY URUGUAY?

Uruguay has a strong democratic tradition, characterized by political and social stability.

Open, growing economy with reliable and high level institutions and a modern and attractive investment regime.

Uruguay is one of the fastest growing countries in Latin America. Its GDP grew, on annual average, 5.8% in 2006-2012.

The country is free from epidemics and racial or religious conflicts.

In Uruguay, education is compulsory by law from 5 to 15 years of age.

Literacy rate: 98%

The government guarantees free access to education, from kindergarten through college.

100% of high school students at 15 years of age have completed at least 3 years of English and 2 years of IT studies.

21% of university students are enrolled in accounting, finance and business administration programs.

17% of university students are enrolled in science and technology.


